- Redesigning our children in church Sunday beginning in September to make it more family focused, as a starting point to develop other opportunities for family focused worship.

- Explore the introduction of an alternative style service on Saturday or Sunday evening to incorporate a different style of music/music group/PowerPoint/discussions – on the third weekend of the month
- Build up the Wednesday morning service with sermon, more music, and coffee afterwards, starting this month
- Once a year host a lay ministry appreciation service
