Background

In 1988, the Utas family, in memory of their son, established the Richard Gordon Utas Trust. The objectives of the Trust are to support children and parents in need by providing financial assistance for recreational, cultural and academic programs with a view to promoting the mental, moral, physical and social well-being and development of all those children who may benefit.

Past distributions from the Trust have supported:

- Youth attending Diocesan, YMCA and YWCA camps
- Special glasses for a young person suffering Irlen Syndrome
- Hockey, basketball and other athletic upgrading or camps
- Music, drama and dance programs, including individual tuition
- Special programs for deaf or blind children
- Scouts and Girl Guides based on individually identified needs.

The Trust is administered inside the Consolidated Trust Fund (CTF) in the Diocese of Edmonton. In accordance with the rules of operation of the CTF, eighty-five percent (85%) of the annual income is available for distribution.

The Board of Trustees meets in early June each year to review applications for funding.
